OhioMATYC Distinguished Service Award

Think about your colleagues across the state and their involvement in mathematics. Is there someone who springs to mind when you think of service to mathematics education? Do you know someone who is involved in professional organizations relating to mathematics? Do you know someone who is actively involved in sharing ideas through presentations or publications? Do you know someone who works to promote mathematics and mathematics education at the local, state, and/or national level?

If someone comes to mind, please take a moment of your time and recognize his or her efforts by nominating that person for the OhioMATYC Distinguished Service Award. The award has been established to recognize professors who have contributed to mathematics education and is awarded bi-annually. Nominations are accepted in the spring of odd years and the award is presented at the spring OhioMATYC meeting.

To be eligible for the award:

- 1. The person must currently be a member of OhioMATYC.
- 2. The person must have at least five years college teaching experience in mathematically related courses.
- 3. Members of the executive committee are not eligible.
- 4. Previous awardees are not eligible for nominations until three other awardees have been recognized.

Guidelines for Nominations:

The nominee should:

- 1. Have service to mathematics education locally and regionally and/or nationally.
- 2. Have been involved in professional presentations and publications related to mathematics education.
- 3. Have any other service or information not mentioned above such as awards, grants, other positions held, etc.

The short nomination form requires only a few minutes to complete. The executive committee will serve as the selection committee and nominees will be asked to provide additional information to the selection committee about their service.
