2025-OhioMATYC Annual Conference OPEN FORUM Minutes April 4, 2025 (4:00-4:30 PM)

- Format of Future Annual Conferences
 - o 2026 Annual Conference location
 - Considering Rhodes or Sinclair again for next year
 - o Consider State Park for the 55th Annual Conference
 - More expensive option so we can't plan for a State Park every year.
 - Need to plan for 2-days
 - Would need more presentations
 - o Do we need to bring our own media equipment?
 - Projectors, etc?
 - Save the date notice sending out early
 - The board worked hard to get the conference center booked earlier this year this allowed us to ask for proposals earlier as well as prepare and publicize our conference program earlier.
 - We would like to keep a similar timeline for next year.
 - We believe that this earlier timeline helped increase our participation/attendance this year.
 - Moving conference proposal deadlines forward
 - The date we sent it out this year seemed to work well, keep with a similar deadline for next year.

- We could consider setting a date (ex. Last week in February) so that people can plan around the date each year.
- We could also consider doing a conference in the same location for 2-years in a row.
- Comments, Thoughts, and Ideas
 - o Increase membership numbers
 - How do we keep up with all the changes at each of the colleges and maintain communication?
 - Reach out to High Schools, especially CCP teachers
 - Reach out to adjunct faculty
 - Explore Institutional Membership
 - Bring your friend to a conference for a discount for both? (NOT at the state park)
 - Record sessions during the conference and provide access to the membership (could charge a small amount to provide access to a few of the sessions – wouldn't want the whole conference broadcast since we don't want a virtual conference)
 - Explore college representatives/point of contact
 - Member connectivity throughout the year
 - Consider hosting a monthly zoom meeting where people could join an open forum
 - Or we could pose a topic and have ½ hour on a topic and ½ hour open discussion.
 - ONets with topics such as Professional Development, AI & Tech, Student Success, OER
 - Could use Facebook as a way of communicating/groups
 - YouTube account to post videos
